Lisa is co-author of Mosby's latest Pocket Guide, *Fetal Monitoring: A Multidisciplinary Approach*, and the developer and creator of the ReadRight EFM ruler and ReadRight EFM Differentials. Along with co-author Dr. David Miller, Lisa has provided "train-the-trainer" sessions for a joint initiative between ACOG District II and the Healthcare Association of New York State, with physician, midwifery and nursing participants from over 90 hospitals. Her international presentations include addressing error and safety in perinatal care for the program *Controversies in OB-GYN*, Paris, 2008 and *The World Congress of Perinatal Medicine*, Berlin, 2009. - Define and recognize all elements of EFM tracing including: FHR baseline, variability, accelerations, decelerations; and uterine contraction characteristics using the standard NICHD nomenclature.
- Discern abnormal FHR tracings relative to dysrhythmias.
- Recognize common perinatal complications, noting both maternal and fetal responses.
- Evaluate interventions and modify the plan of care.
- Apply current standards of practice, documentation essentials and legal principles relative to electronic fetal monitoring.
